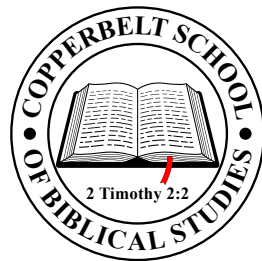

As children of God, we have a great need to go into all the world and spread the good news that there is a Savior, Jesus Christ, who offers salvation to all. Realizing the command of our Lord to “preach the word,” we continue to train men throughout Africa and here in the USA to fulfill that same command (2 Timothy 4:2). Since 1988, we now have six schools of preaching in four different countries that are committing the word of God to faithful men who will lead the lost to Christ.

In the United States, the Bible Institute of Missouri was established to reach out to the lost all across the nation. In East Africa, we have two schools: one in Uganda and another in Kenya. In West Africa, we have another school located in Ghana. In Southern Africa, we now have two schools located in Zambia. One of these schools is in the city of Livingstone, and the other is in the city of Ndola.

Just last month, Ray and I spent time in Ndola, Zambia setting up the second school. We already have over twenty applicants, and we are aiming for around fourteen students for the intake that will begin in February 2024. This school will be making a special effort to reach out to the country of Tanzania that shares the northern border of Zambia. Our hope is that we might be able to enroll students from the neighboring countries, and then after graduating, these students would spread the gospel out into their home countries as well. The Lord has truly been good to afford such an opportunity as this, and we are very thankful.

As many of you know, each of these schools requires funding which is provided by faithful supporters throughout the brotherhood. Last year, we made a special request for one-time funds to fill our budget shortage in 2023; we praise God that we were able to meet that need. The GSOBS budget wouldn't be met without these one-time funds. This year we are making a similar plea for your help in covering our monthly budget shortage for 2024. We are very grateful that we have around 90% of our monthly budget met. To close the gap for the 2024, we will need to raise approximately \$35,000 dollars which will guarantee the training of over *eighty* students in six schools. There may be a congregation or an individual that would like to make a one-time contribution or monthly contributions to this need. We need your help to continue these necessary works to evangelize the world, and we thank you deeply for your consideration of this need. With God's blessings and our unified efforts, we can accomplish this goal. To God be the glory!



Starting 2024

Ndola, Zambia

We are excited this month to be able to give you more details about our new school in Northern Zambia. It will be called the Copperbelt School of Biblical Studies.

We arrived in November to begin the process of finding a facility to house the school in Ndola, Zambia. Dad and I were joined by brother Scott Richards. This good brother is a long-time missionary and worker in the Lord's kingdom. Through the mission works he oversees, he will be

fully funding the new school in Ndola. We are very thankful and blessed to be working with this good brother.

Why did we decide upon Ndola, Zambia? There are

almost 20 million people who live in Zambia. It's also a land-locked country with seven other nations bordering it. There are plenty of prospective men from Zambia and from the surrounding countries who we will be able to draw from for our student base. Choosing Zambia for a second school also has a couple more great benefits: we already have a registration to operate in the country, and there are many faithful and trained men who we can use in the work as teachers. Having two schools in Zambia will give us the ability to train between 30 to 40 men in Zambia altogether, rather than only half of this amount.

We now have three teachers chosen who are ready to begin the work in February. They are Ziko Mulenga, Michelo Siamdwa, and Costain

Muchindu. We are so excited about the prospect of the new school beginning and are glad to say that everything is falling into place.

We were able to secure a facility while in Ndola and get it under contract. We are currently making some adjustments and building another building on the property to meet our needs.

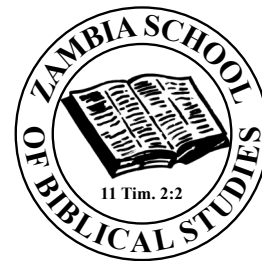
Please keep all these plans and preparations in your daily prayers so that God will continue to bless us to get this school up and running and to continue to accomplish great things in Southern Africa.

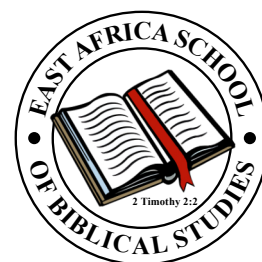
